The overarching theme of my research portfolio centers around diet and chronic disease prevention among Hispanics, with particular interest in the following main focal areas (illustrated in Figure 1): (1) identifying factors contributing to diet quality and chronic disease risk among Hispanics; (2) assessing the role of the home food environment on dietary behaviors and as an intervention target for diet improvement; and (3) designing, implementing, and evaluating culturally-relevant interventions for chronic disease risk reduction in Hispanic individuals and families.
