> ASU CURRICULUM DESIGN

Original Courses Created and Developed:

• Expanded Arts (ART 194)

This course was proposed and created to help undergraduate students develop meaning in their artwork by practicing innovative conceptual making. I worked in collaboration with ASU faculty to workshop the class and I personally designed a semester's worth of curriculum for Expanded Arts prior to its launch in Fall 2022.

• HIDA SOA "Class Experience" (Online)

An original "virtual classroom experience" designed in partnership with SOA Asc. Dir. melissa m button. This 2 Hour course included theoretical and hands-on experiences with color. I designed fun and engaging virtual exercises for Zoom. The course ran June 23rd, 2020, and again on April 12th, 2021. (Link to press release here)

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Undergrad Courses Redesigned and Taught:

• Ceramic Vessels (ART 367)

I overhauled the curriculum to better cover hand-building techniques and conceptual development in addition to wheel-throwing. All content was original.

• Ceramics for Non-Majors (ART 394) (Hybrid)

I created original curriculum and original methods utilizing various forms of tech to instruct ART 394 remotely with ½ of students in person and ½ online.

• Ceramics Survey (ART 261) (Online)

Due to Covid-19, this course was taught entirely online without the use of a ceramic studio. To accommodate students working from home, I created affordable and accessible course material. I utilized my personally owned technology and tailored instructional methods to enhance the student experience via Zoom.

• 3D Design (ART 115) (Hybrid)

In 2019, I re-designed the curriculum to better cover conceptual development and experimental construction. In 2020, I had to abruptly transform ART 115 to an online course due of Covid-19. I made bespoke exercises and used an array of software to keep students connected and learning about 3D design. All original content.
