Project Description: The artists collaborated with Flathead Lake Biological Station scientist Mark Lorang to create a multimedia piece for narration, computer music, dance and computer animation to artistically translate how the sounds of the rivers influence waterway ecosystems. The process began with Lorang writing a detailed description of his research that inspired Mark Gibbon's poetry. Nichols composed music by processing and mixing recordings of sounds from the research floats down the Middle Fork Flathead River, ambient noise at the research station, vibrations from along the river bank and the readings of Gibbon's text. Bradley Browning set choreography and Bushnell devised computer-generated animation that reflects the subject of the research, the poetry and the musical composition.
