I mentored 12 MPH students as primary supervisors in B.P. Koirala Institute of Health Sciences, Nepal and two PhD students (one in University of Queensland and another in Curtin university) as co-supervisors between 2016-2022.

Curriculum Design and Course Lead Experience

HCD 303: Global Healthcare System (Activity: 2023 Summer and Fall)

I updated and enhanced HCD 303 Global Healthcare System course to make it more inclusive in global perspective in consultation with the course lead, Rijwana Biviji. I introduced new concepts and contents such as health system frameworks, design, financing mechanisms, primary health care, universal health coverage, comparative healthcare system analysis and population health management with integrated healthcare system.

Especially, I developed two modules: health system frameworks and governance; and comparative healthcare system analysis with addition of two important e-books and several articles in Canvas shell of HCD 303. Altogether, I recorded 10 video lectures of 15-20 minutes for this course during the summer of 2023. I have also revised In-Class activities and Yellowdig topics that includes new topics such as role of government, health system frameworks, social health insurance in India/Nepal; and this will enhance the global inclusiveness of the course.

POP 100: Introduction to Population Health Redesign and Course lead (Activity: 2023 Fall-2025 Spring)

I led the redesign of POP 100 course in consultation with Zach Cordell, Lauren Savaglio and Joshua Anbar. The redesigned course was offered in the fall of 2024 both in on-line and hybrid format for the first time. During the process, new textbook was adopted and 7 modules were redesigned with 16 new recorded lectures and Yellowdig for discussion topics. One of the new focus and new modules in this course is Public Health Workforce and Education to discuss public health services, occupations, workforce and careers. I also updated the group work project and presentation with new instruction guidelines and rubrics.

This redesigned course was offered both in hybrid and online format in the fall of 2024. I received students' and peer reviewer's feedback on this course and revised the learning materials, group project, and quizzes in Spring, 2025.

New course Development: PBH 494 Global Sexual and Reproductive Health (Activity 2023 Fall-2025 Summer)

I developed the new course "PBH 494: Global Sexual and Reproductive Health". The work started in Fall, 2023 with syllabus approved from Curriculum Committee of CHS and subsequently passed through Instructional Design. I completed developing this course in 2024 Fall in hybrid format working with CHS teaching academy. I continued working on this course with CHS online Instructional Design in Spring and Summer, 2025 to convert it into online interactive format, with the help of AI.

This course explores key components and interventions in sexual and reproductive health both from a domestic and global perspective in line with Sustainable Development Goals 3 and 5. Seven modules were developed with 14 recorded video lectures and seven discussion topics. Group work (policy paper and presentation with instructions and rubrics), and quizzes for modules, midterm and final exam were prepared for course assessments.

HCD 420: Population Health Management (Activity 2023 Fall-2024 Spring)

I taught HCD 420 Population Health Management course for the first time in Spring of 2024. I got 7 lecture videos recorded and used PlayPosit tool to host these lecture videos.

HCD 520 Population Health (in-person, Activity 2025 Spring)

I taught this in-person course in the Spring of 2025. I revised this course and updated in-person course shell. I prepared new lecture and learning materials including 12 PowerPoints; 6 in-class discussion topics and scenarios; and four new journal articles for in-class presentation. These new and revised materials were in the modules: health inequity and social determinants; workforce diversity and its development; health promotion and behavior change; and policy and advocacy. I also prepared quiz questions for midterm and final exams.
