Online Class Developed and Taught at the University Level

- NTR445 Management of Food Service Systems
 - Development: This course is provided in an immersion/lab format, and I created an online version to
 meet the degree requirements for the Food & Entrepreneurship online degree. Case studies were
 developed to address each concept that are provided in the lab environment. All lectures were
 recorded, online exams developed, and discussion board (yellow dig/Canvas discussion boards) created
 to facilitate student engagement.

Full Immersion Class Developed and Taught at the University Level

- NTR498 Child Nutrition Seminar
 - Development: This course was developed to meet requirements of the School Nutrition Certificate.
 Areas covered included career opportunities in school nutrition, understanding the role and function of
 the USDA National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and context of how the rules and regulations of the
 NSLP are applied every day in school cafeterias around the country. Guest lecturers from Arizona
 Department of Education, local food brokers, food service directors and suppliers where include in the
 course schedule.
 - Major update in Spring 2024. Created multiple modules using new technology- CourseArc. Encouraged more interactive learning, variety of assessments (quizzes, matching, fill in the blank, etc). Created 3 new project options for students to complete in lieu of exams.

Full Immersion Classes Re-Designed and Taught at the University Level

- NTR400 Preprofessional Preparation in Dietetics (completely redesigned for Fall 2018)
 - Redesign: Completely revised the course shell to allow for more organization and clear progression through the course. Added several other project options for students to select from each year. Created mentoring opportunity for senior and freshmen (NTR150) dietetic students (both individual projects and class wide mentoring day). Added networking event for students to meet practicing RD/RDNs to learn about different opportunities in the career field.
- NTR445 Management of Food Service Systems (completely redesigned spring 2014 and for ASU Sync)
 - Redesign: Capstone project students complete in lab was redefined, clarified and added to in order to provide more opportunities to enhance their supervisory/management skills. Added several guest lectures on food safety, school nutrition, clinical food service management and retail operations. Worked with co-instructor (lab instructor, Chef Kent Moody) to add special lab days to review how to cost menu items, create production orders, and develop printed menus. Added specific in class activity to improve understanding of standardized recipe formulation. In Spring of 2020, moved all paper-based assignments to online versions to accommodate COVID restrictions. These transitions worked so well that I no longer have students turn in anything paper based. All assignments, portfolios and exams are now submitted via Canvas. This has greatly reduced paper waste.

Hybrid Class Re-Designed and Taught at the University Level

- NTR343 Food Service Purchasing (completely redesigned Summer of 2012)
 - Redesign: To allow for full understanding of the scope of food service purchasing, I developed a semester long group project. Groups would develop their own food service business (brick and mortar or food trucks), determine the theme/menu items and appearance. Each week the specific procurement principal covered would be applied to the group mock business. Students completed assignments based on how that principle (such as purchasing appliances) would impact their business and determine how they would proceed with that specific purchase. This more real-world approach provided more context and understanding of mostly dry and unappealing concepts. This redesign was provided to the new faculty who took this course over in fall 2016 and is still being utilized today.
